**Afternoon program 8<sup>th</sup> March:** Research for the debate.

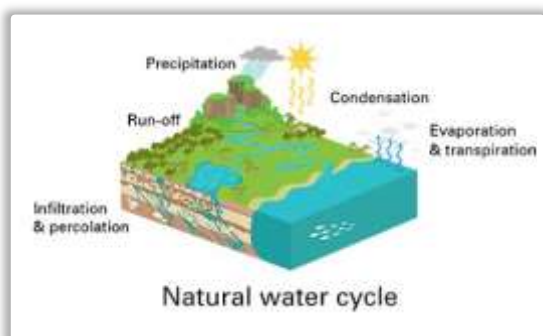
**Afternoon program 15<sup>th</sup> March:** Documentary film viewing and discussion.
